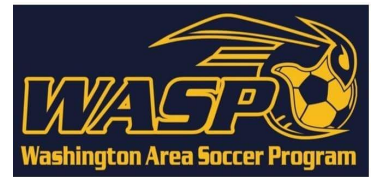


WASP Brisk 6v6 Tournament Rules

The Washington Area Soccer Program is hosting a 6 vs. 6 recreational high school co-ed tournament. It will be held November 4th outdoors in sun, rain, or snow, regardless of temperature. All funds will benefit WASP youth. Teams will be placed in a bracket randomly, every team is guaranteed at least two games, with games beginning at 9 a.m. There is a limit of 8 teams. Medals will be awarded to the first place team.

Entry is due by 5 p.m., October 28th: must include team roster, signed team waiver, and fee.

Team fee - \$200 (up to 10 players/team = \$20/athlete)

RULES: All USSF rules will apply except:

- No off-sides.
- Unlimited substitutions can be made during throw ins or goal kicks for either team.
- Punting or drop kicking by the goalkeeper will NOT be permitted. The following infraction will result in an indirect free kick from the halfway line to the opposing team.
- Throw-ins will be used when the ball is out-of-bounds.
- Defenders must remain at least 5 yards from ball on all restarts.
- Play 6v6 includes 5 field players and a goalkeeper. Maximum roster 10.
 - Only current high school students are permitted to play
 - Acceptable identification includes current player cards or school ID
 - Players may only play on one team
 - An official team roster must be submitted to WASP with entry form by Oct. 28.
 - Check in will be held one hour prior to the team's first game.
- At least one female player must be on the field at all times.
- 6.5x18.5 goals will be used and the field will be approximately 60 x 40 yards.
- Teams cannot score from their own half of the field.
- First team listed is the home team and will kick-off first.
- If a game is tied at the end of regulation penalty kicks will be held.
 - **- Penalty Shootout Procedure:** Three kicks to be taken by any three players on the roster. If two teams are still tied after three kicks, the same three players will take the additional kicks on a sudden death basis.
- All players must wear shin-guards during play.
- Players who receive a red card will be ejected for the remainder of the game and are not allowed to play in the next game.
- Games will be two 25-minute halves with running time. Half time period is five minutes, no time outs.
- No tolerance policy – The tournament directors will not accept any abuse of referees or officials. The directors reserve the right to eject and ban from the tournament any individual or team who has abused an official, be it club volunteer or certified referee. Any coach or team official shall be held responsible for the action of any individual who in the opinion of the referee or tournament official, is a supporter of that team.
- If the tournament gets behind, game times may be shortened at the discretion of the tournament director.
- Slide tackling is NOT allowed and results in a direct free kick from the spot of the foul.

ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL BE FINAL
